Applications for places in the Junior School years P4 to P7 and in the Senior School years S1 to S6 are to include a Work Sample which will afford us an opportunity to learn something about your child in his/her own words.

Guidelines

- the writing should be entitled **Myself** and be a free-ranging piece which might discuss personality, likes and dislikes, hobbies and interests, ambitions, and what the child is looking forward to at St Aloysius' College; in brief, the writing may be on anything that interests the child or young person about him or herself.
- there is no set length for the sample; P4 candidates may wish to write about 150 words; P7, S1 and older candidates may wish to write more but should not exceed 500 words; it is suggested that the work is done on lined A4 paper but any paper is acceptable.
- we would encourage parents to discuss ideas for the work sample with their children before they put pen to paper; once this initial discussion has taken place, however, the work should be the child's own.
