

College Bus Services 2022/23

Introduction

In order to provide a safe and direct transport option for our families and cut down cars travelling into Glasgow City Centre, St Aloysius' College, alongside bus operator MacPhails, operate a number of different routes bringing our pupils (Primary 1 – S6) into school and back home.

The PM bus leaves at 4.45pm Monday – Thursday and 3.45pm on a Friday. This is to ensure our pupils are able to fully participate in school activities including after school clubs.

Aftercare facilities are available for pupils in Primary 1-3 where clubs are not available.

Kindergarten pupils are not permitted to use the bus services.

Please note:

The pricing structure is a trial until June 2023 when it will be reviewed.

Booking Procedure

Bookings for any of our pupils are done through our designated booking system Vectare at https://staloysius.vectare.co.uk/

Through this portal, you can choose the bus route, bus stop and whether you will be using the bus in the AM, PM or both.

If you have more than one child you will have to book each child individually.

Payment is then securely made through Vectare and can be done so on a termly, yearly or ad hoc basis.

Cancellation Procedure

With more than 24 hours' notice

If you have booked your child on the bus but have to cancel with more than 24 hours' notice, you **must** inform us as soon as you are aware by emailing our Transport Co-ordinator at **buses@staloysius.org**.

With less than 24 hours' notice

For cancellations closer to the booking (due to overnight illness, for example) we ask that you still email our Transport Co-ordinator at buses@staloysius.org but also email the bus operator, MacPhails, directly in order to ensure their drivers are aware. Please copy in the email address macPhailsoffice@aol.com.

Any cancellations due to illness will also need to follow the correct absence policy for the College – contacting the appropriate class teacher/pastoral office.

If your child is booked on the bus and they decide to make alternative arrangements home from school (with your permission), they should inform reception or their head of year prior to leaving in order to be removed from the bus register.

We are unable to refund any cancelled or unused bookings.

Pupil Rules

The following rules have been put in place for the safety of all our pupils using the bus and the drivers of the bus.

- Pupils should get off and on the bus in a sensible and safe manner, sitting down in their seat immediately when they get on the bus.
- Pupils must remain in their seat at all times with their seatbelt securely fastened **never** getting up and walking up and down the aisle when the bus is in motion.
- > Always sit facing forward no kneeling to talk to other pupils in front or behind.
- Do not distract the driver at any point.
- > Follow all instructions given by the driver.
- No eating, drinking or litter on the bus.
- > All bags placed on the floor in front of seats.

Terms and Conditions

All users of the College bus services agree to the following:

- All pupils must behave in accordance with the pupil rules detailed above.
- > Seatbelts must be word at all times on the buses.
- Pupils should be at their designated bus stop at least 5-minutes prior to the scheduled pick-up time.
- All pupils will be registered when they get on and off the bus.
- St Aloysius' College cannot accept responsibility for children until they reach the College.
- > Bus drivers and St Aloysius' College cannot be responsible for ensuring pupils get off at the correct bus stop.
- MacPhails and St Aloysius' College cannot take responsibility for buses left on the bus. Items may be returned to lost property at the school. Please contact St Aloysius' College reception or the bus provider directly.
- > Cancellations must be done through the procedure detailed in this document.
- No refunds will be given for cancelled or unused journeys.
- If families use the bus but have not paid for the trip, bus charges will be added to your billing account. A register is taken on every bus journey.

Frequently Asked Questions

What time do the buses leave school?

The buses leave school at 4.45pm Monday – Thursday and 3.45pm on a Friday. This is so that as many pupils as possible can take part in after school clubs and activities and are still able to get the bus after.

On the last day of term and other half day holidays (for example, Ogilvie Day) the bus will leave at 12.15pm.

Can I track my child on the bus?

There is no online tracking facility, however, for safeguarding purposes, a manifest of all pupils booked onto each bus is giving to the driver and they mark them on and off the bus.

This is why it is important to inform someone as soon as possible if your child will not be on the bus.

Where can my child go while they wait for the bus to leave?

There will always be an after-school club your child can attend, including homework club. In Senior School, there is a designated study area for pupils while they wait on the bus if they do not want to attend a club.

What if the bus is delayed or there is bad weather?

The bus driver will inform the company's head office if there are any major delays in picking up/dropping off children. An email will then be sent to parents/carers.

Unfortunately, we cannot control all aspects and things like roadworks may mean the bus is not arriving at the designated time.

Please ensure you contact details, including mobile number, are always kept up-to-date with the school/booking system in case we need to contact you at short notice.

Can I get a refund if I cancel the bus?

Unfortunately, we cannot offer refunds for cancelled or unused trips.

I just want to use the bus in the morning, does the system let me do this?

Yes. You are able to choose whether you would like a single journey in the morning or afternoon, or return journey.

Can my child get on at one stop and off at another, or another bus entirely?

Yes. You will be able to choose one stop for the AM journey and one stop for the PM journey. You can also add different bus journeys for the same day.

It is up to the pupil to be familiar with the bus stop they are getting off at.

Is the bus supervised?

No. The College is not responsible for pupils while on the bus and there is no supervision. We recommend that younger pupils travel with older siblings or family members.

If you do not have an older sibling, we would be happy to buddy younger pupils up on the bus. Our Pastoral team would deal with this.
