**S1 Assessment overview**

From Friday 1 May to Wednesday 13 May, all pupils in S1 will make submissions to their teachers that will be used to assess pupil progress. The table on the following page gives further details on the assessments from each subject. More detailed information will be released to pupils from their subject teacher on Schoology.

Subjects highlighted in yellow will use open-ended tasks that can be completed at any point but must be submitted by the date given. All information relating to these open-ended tasks will be released on or before Monday 4 May.

All other subjects will use on-line assessments (using Schoology, Kahoot or MS Forms). These will be released at 9am on the day specified and must be completed by 4pm that day. A generous time allocation will be given for each on-line assessment (usually 1 hour) but pupils will only have one attempt at these assessments. The time allocation factors in the additional time those with additional arrangements would normally receive.

All submissions are 'open-book' i.e. pupils can use their notes at home to help them. However, pupils are reminded that all work **MUST** be their own when completing their tasks/assessments. They should not contact other pupils or seek help from others as it is important that the submission made is a reflection of the pupil's own efforts.

To allow pupils to concentrate on these tasks, teachers will not issue any new learning or homework throughout this period.
