## PARENTS EVENING POLICY - Guidance for pupils - Senior School

- 1. Pupils must ask to make an appointment with every teacher. If a teacher does not need to see parents the teacher will inform pupils this is never a decision for a pupil to make.
- 2. Pupils ask parents what time they wish to begin appointments before they start booking times.
- 3. Appointments are made in class and recorded in small prayer/organiser book.
- 4. Pupils must leave a 5-minute gap after each appointment.
- 5. Pupils are to attend parents' evenings in uniform with their parents.
- 6. Pupils should keep to the times of their scheduled appointments. If pupils are running late, or if a teacher is busy, pupils should skip on and keep to the times listed for the teacher. Pupils can return to missed appointments later.

## PARENTS EVENING POLICY - GUIDANCE FOR PUPILS - Junior School

Parents Evening: Junior School

The Junior School parents evening is an appointment based event to meet and discuss a pupils' progress with the child's class teacher and specialist teachers.

## Guidance:

- 1. Letters sent out to parents to request preferential day and late / early appointment where possible.
- 2. Parents evening is run over two evenings: 1) 5-8pm and 2) 4-6pm to help accommodate working parents.
- 3. 10 minute appointments are organised for all parents. Sibling groups are organised on same evening so that parents can discuss all their children with the different teachers.
- 4. 5 minute appointments with specialists arranged on same evening on a first come basis.
- 5. Parents are given a slip via class teachers showing all appointment times for their children.
- 6. Any parent who cannot attend Parents Evening is encouraged to meet with teachers out with this time.
- 7. Any issues which arise on Parents' Evening are fed back to Head of Section/Head Teacher.
- 8. HoS are available to meet with parents on both evenings to help with any situations which arise or discuss progress.
- 9. Prefects help direct parents to appointments and help keep appointments to time on both evenings.
- 10. Children do not attend Parents' Evening.
